The Salal Chapter of Washington Native Plant Society is dedicated to the preservation, conservation, and study of the native plants of Washington and to the education of the public on the values of native flora and its habitat. We invite students to apply for financial assistance to attend a Washington Native Plant Society (WNPS) educational event (*Study Weekend or Botany WA*) or for assistance with the purchase of materials for completion of coursework related to the natural sciences. Applications are due on March 31st. Up to 4 scholarships may be awarded. Applicants should be enrolled in a high school or college program in natural sciences. Successful applicants will be notified by mid-April in order to expedite registration in one of the WNPS events. Awards will be given in 2 installments. One half will be awarded immediately and the second half will be awarded after completion of the chosen program. A requirement for the 2nd installment will be a one-page summary of how the funds were used, which lectures and/or field trips or courses were taken with assistance from the scholarship.
